RESEARCH INTERESTS

My primary research interests involve the neuropsychology of psychotic disorders.

My main focus has been on the neuropsychological correlates of lack of illness awareness in schizophrenia. I have also undertaken research into cognitive deficits in the 22q 11 deletion syndrome and its relationship with schizophrenia. The re-mediation of cognitive deficits in schizophrenia is another area of endeavour.

I continue to undertake research in the area of substance abuse with a particular interest on cognitive deficits related to the use of MDMA ("Ecstasy").

Finally, I am interested in the field of minor closed head injuries and their relationship to other syndromes, such as fibromyalgia.
